

McCullough Park Rules & Regulations

Please make camping a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:

Campsites: All campsites are BACK-IN-SITES only. Keep vehicles on the gravel pad provided. DO NOT PARK vehicles on the grass.

Camping Units: Only one camping unit per site. Camping unit is defined as one RV, camper, tent OR trailer (equipped to be lived in/slept in). The only exception to this would be for a family with children under 18, may have one extra tent, on site, to be used for the children.

Maximum Number of People Per Site: Site occupancy is limited to one family unit (persons living under one household) or one non-family unit limited to six people per site. Anyone renting a campsite must be 18 years of age or older and must be present at the campsite.

Motor Vehicles & Boat Trailers: Only two cars per campsite are allowed. Boat trailers must be parked on the camping site pad or in the day use/overflow parking lot. All vehicles and campers must be operational. No construction/automotive repairs allowed in campground (minor boat repairs allowed). DO NOT PARK vehicles or boat trailers on grass. Extra vehicles and boat trailers may be parked in the day use/overflow parking lot. Park only in designated areas.

Boat Dock Parking: No overnight parking.

Firewood & Fires: Only DNR Certified Firewood may be brought onsite. Firewood is not provided. Campers must only use local DNR certified firewood that has been provided by a local DNR certified provider. Fires are permitted only in provide fire rings. Gas and propane stoves are permitted. Please be careful with fire. Fires must be attended at all times and extinguished before leaving the campsite.

Pets: Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All pet waste must be properly removed. Campers with barking dogs will be asked to leave the campground.

Visitors, Quiet Hours and Noise: Visitors are welcome to campsites from 8 am to 10 pm. Campers must not disturb the sleep of others between 10 pm and 8 am.

Check-in/Check-out Time: Check-in time is 3 pm. Campsites must be vacated by 2 pm.

Severe Weather: Campers are encouraged to go to the restroom/shower building during severe weather.

Fireworks or Explosives: No fireworks or explosives are allowed in the park.

Garbage & Recycling: Please place all garbage and recycling in the receptacles provided by the shower building.

Dump Station: The Dump Station is only for registered campers. All non-registered campers must pay a \$10 dump fee.
