Family Child Care SUID/AHT “Off Year” Video Training Verification

Minnesota Statutes, section 245A.50, requires sudden unexpected infant death (SUID) training for all license holders, staff persons, caregivers and helpers who assist in the care of infants. Abusive head trauma (AHT) training is required for all license holders, staff persons, caregivers, and helpers who care for infants and child under school age. On the years when the license holder is not receiving SUID and AHT training face-to-face (“off year”), in a classroom, or online, the license holder must receive SUID and AHT training through a video of no more than one hour in length.

While no specific method of verification is required, you may print this page for documentation that you have watched each of the approved videos to fulfill your training requirement for the “off year.”
