Filing for county, state and federal offices opens May 17

The race to November's general election officially begins Tuesday, May 17 with the opening of the initial filing period. Filing for county, state and federal offices begins at 8 a.m. May 17 and ends at 5 p.m., Tuesday, May 31.

Filing offices are closed on Memorial Day, Monday, May 30.

Candidates for federal offices must file at the Office of the Secretary of State, State Office Building, Room 180, 100 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., St. Paul. Filing for state offices can be done at the Office of the Secretary of State or with the county auditor of the county in which the candidate resides.

Candidates may file in person or by mail, if the filing is received during the filing period. Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09 (1a), may arrange to file during the week immediately preceding the candidate's absence.
