Morristown was founded in 1855 around a Grist Mill business built near a natural dam that formed along the Cannon River. While the mill has ceased its operations, it is a focal point at local festivals and events showcasing the town's history and the unique mill operation. Morristown has a small town environment and the benefit of being close to the major roadways, leading to the Twin Cities and other parts of Minnesota. The town has a strong agricultural base and serves as a home to several farming and related supply businesses. Morristown is also known for its wide range of recreational activities, from fishing and camping to hiking along nature trails.

The "effective" labor market covers much of Rice County and stretches toward Mankato and Owatonna.

The Morristown EDA provides grants for eligible new businesses, and low interest loans for eligible business projects. Morristown will also work with private, county, regional, and state economic development partners to provide grants, loans and other incentives and programs.
